Enrollment and Tuition Information 2008-2009

Please read application procedures and instructions carefully:

Enrollment Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First, you should contact FEAT of Washington and request an observation of the RSA program. This observation will last for 30 minutes, and FEAT's Clinical Services Director will guide you through the observation. 2. Fill out the application form. Please note that FEAT will not send any acknowledgment of receipt of applications – this should be arranged with your local post office, if so desired. 3. Current FEAT members and their participating typical siblings will be given priority. 4. Once application is received, an assessment appointment with the Program Director will be scheduled, if necessary. This meeting will last for 1 hour. This admissions screening meeting will occur between you and FEAT's Clinical Services Director. During the meeting, you will complete a social skills screening assessment related to your child. The goal of this assessment is to help FEAT get an idea of how your child's social skills compare to those of other children of the same age. The assessment will be scored during the meeting, and depending on the results, the Clinical Services Director will speak with you about when you might be able to enroll your child in RSA. 5. If both you and the FEAT staff agree to enroll your child, your child will then begin in RSA on a week-to-week trial enrollment for the next four weeks. During this time, the RSA staff will be busy getting to know your child and her or his preferences, seeing how your child reacts to the classroom environment, and determining whether the staff thinks the RSA program will be a good and beneficial fit with your child's unique needs. At the end of that month-long trial enrollment, you will have a meeting with the staff of RSA and both you and they will determine whether RSA is the right placement for your child. If you all agree that RSA is the right place for your child, then your child will be enrolled in RSA on a permanent basis.

Application/Assessment	<p>There is a nonrefundable \$100 application and/or assessment fee. Upon initial admission, director/teacher will meet with the family for assessment, as needed. All students should post their deposit for the following amount to reserve their spot for the next school year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Deposit Amounts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ \$375/student for RSA only (9 AM – 12 Noon) ○ \$1500/student for RSA with 3 days EIBI option (9 AM-12 Noon, Tue & Thu; 9AM – 3:30 PM, MWF) ○ \$1750/student for RSA with 5 days EIBI option (9 AM – 3:30 PM, M-F) <p>Deposit is due by July 10, 2008 and will be credited towards the tuition for the first month. There will be no deposit refunds should a student withdraw after August 10, 2008.</p>

<u>Absences:</u>	Absence for any reason, does not affect monthly tuition payments.
<u>Withdrawals:</u>	<p>Because FEAT of Washington hires its staff on a yearly basis, the intention of the parent's financial commitment is for the full school year.</p> <p><u>In the event of the parents' decision to withdraw the child(ren), the parent will provide a 30-days advance written notice to FEAT of WA's Office Manager. Tuition for the month through the 30-day period must be paid in full.</u></p> <p>In the event of withdrawal at the request of the teacher, the 30-day period of notification is waived.</p>
